Installation

you may need to perform a few extra steps to prevent interference or faulty operation of your remote controls.



Turning off the power

To avoid possible electrical shock, before

installing your fan, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breakers to the outlet box ociated with the wall switch location.

Before installation, use the pull chains to set the fan speed to HIGH and the light to ON. Ensure the power is OFF at the outlet box and wall switch location before proceeding with installation.




Slide the cradle onto the mounted bracket.



If you are installing into drywall, drill two 9/64 width holes using the cradle bracket as a guide. Gently hammer the included drywall anchors into the pre-drilled holes.

Install the cradle bracket to the wall with the included screws.



Installing the battery


To access the battery compartment, remove the small Phillips head screw that secures the battery door to the remote control.

Replace the used battery with a CR2032 battery when necessary. The battery should be installed with the positive (+) side up.



▲ IMPORTANT

Turning on the power



Pair the remote with a compatible receiver.

> **Note:** To pair your remote, remove the battery door. Cycle power to the fan by turning power off and back on at the wall switch (or circuit breaker if necessary). Within three minutes, press the pair button on the remote.

To prevent faulty operation, please disconnect power from all other ceiling fans within range while pairing.
